## GREAT TREK NORTH

With the start of our tour to the Maryborough Rort now only about a month away we are finalising arrangements and this means, among other things, that we need money to pay our for the bus and accommodation.

At this stage it looks like we will have 36 people on the bus going up and 32 on the return trip.

Unfortunately, but as expected, costs have inflated a bit from our first estimate which was made last August. Cost of the bus has increased to \$4,000 which comes out at \$120 per head for the full trip and \$60 for those travelling up only (Frazers and Clarkes).

Accommodztion varies from \$14 (one place) to \$18 (most places) and works out to \$170 per person for the full trip and \$90 for the up trip only.

On the credit side, however, you will see from the recent (March) issue of Roaring 40's that we will pick up most, if not all of the increase, by the generosity of Maryborough members in offering us billets and the very reasonable cost of the Rort functions.

Roaring 40's is published by Apex 40 to inform members of current events.

What we require is payment for the bus and accommodation by not later than Friday 15th May. The amount payable will be \$290 per person for the whole trip - \$150 per person for those on the up trip only, less deposits already paid. We would like payment as soon as possible but not later than 15th May. Melbourne-Gippsland members may wish to pay some or all of this money at the next dinner.
