Firstly, to those Clubs who have sent in money, your receipt should be pinned to the front cover of one of these newsletters.

To those who have not sent in their Per Capitas -WHY NOT?. those nice forms I sent out last time were not only to opdate the mailing list, it was also a <u>SUBTLE HINT</u> to send in manage.

Next, with regard to the letter your Club probably received from Apex Association, may I, as your NAT.SEC/TRES. strongly recommend that you do not accept the offer to join the Westpac Centralised Banking. The main problem is that the Interest, although at a good rate, is credited direct to APEX ASSOCIATION ACCOUNT.

Their Director has assured me they would promptly remit such interest to us, and while I do not doubt his intentions, it is felt that the system could be prone to mistakes.

If you are not happy with the interest your are getting on your account, may I advise that the NATIONAL AUSTRALIA BANK (for whom I am a humble servant) is paying 13.50% daily on the accounts I have opened. If you are interested, get your local branch to contact me (Brunswick Heads N.S.W.Branch) and we should be able to obtain much the same for your club.

Now , RORT. - KUALA LUMPUR , June 1990.
Most of you by now should have received one of the new coloured brochures/registration forms , IF NOT , AND YOU WANT ONE, THEN CONTACT MYSELF, or Alan Kinder, Len Rankine or Darryl Mercer.

It is mostly straight forward, the only thing I would repeat, they prefer the funds to be sent by Bank Draft (or International Cheque) rather than private cheque. I think the charges are less. The idea would be for each club to get one cheque for all members going. ALSO, note you will have to split up the amount for the West Malaysia tour if you are taking that.

Now, Australia to Kuala Lumpur. The official carrier is MAS Airlines, and the Australian Travel agency who can do the best deal just happens to be "National Aust. Bank Travel" This has been checked by others and we dont think you will get cheaper.

The basic air fare, Sydney/Melbourne - Kuala Lumpur Return is \$825-00.

Now, for those who leave from Brisbane, at present the fare will be an extra \$302- for basic fare, and \$347- if you take the Additional tour.

There is however talks that MAY allow MAS to fly direct out of Brisbane, if this happens by the time we are due to leave, then the fare ex Brisbane Should be approx. the same as from Melbourne or Sydney.

Now, if You are taking the additional West Malaysia Tour, you will note that on Sunday 17th. you go from K.L. to Singapore, then return on Tues.19th. to K.L., to catch plane back to Australia - that is because the return MUST leave from K.L.

Therefor, as part of the deal , and for an extra \$45-00 each , you can pay for that section with your Aust. - K.L. fare. MAS and National Bank Travel have arranged this for us.

To keep some order to the arrangements, I ask that you please make your Australian - K.L. travel bookings through either Alan Kinder, or Myself. We have the name of the Travel Officer, who at this time has 150 seats reserved. By the time you read this, Alan and I will know how much deposit has to be paid, by when, and when the balance has to be paid. So please contact Alan or Myself, give us your Surname and Christian name, your address and a phone number. If we are not there at the time, leave a message and we will get back to you.
