It is almost a year now since we left you all at Alstonville. Time now to again renew friendships at Berri. I am looking forward to a great weekend with both old and new friends.

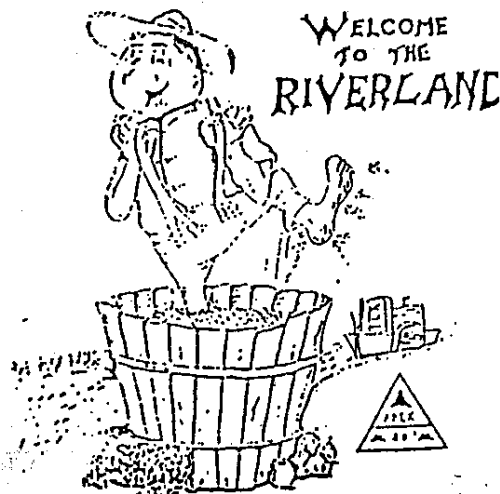
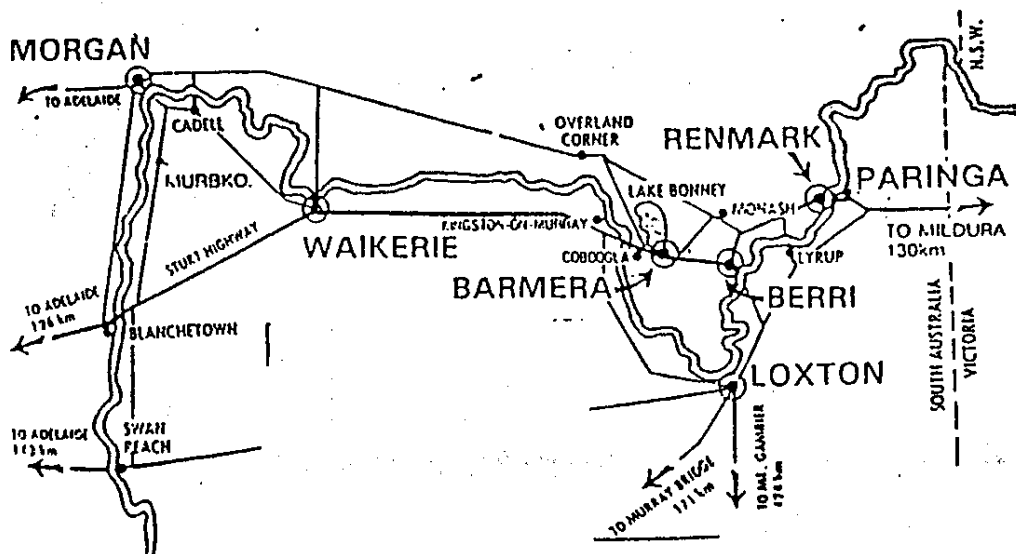

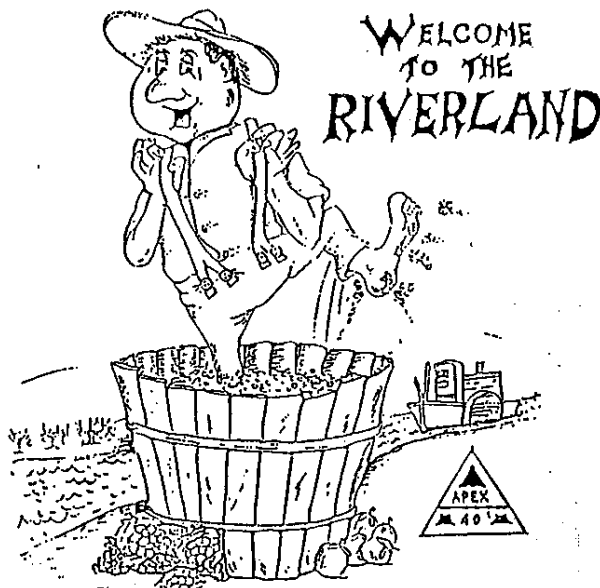
